CHAPTER VII REFUTING PLUTOCRACY

(The foregoing paragraphs discuss the absolute impossibility of establishing a plutocratic capitalistic society in China.)

In case of particular conditions (as the capitalist won over the Greek Invasion while the power of the proletariat is too weak), there happened a Kemalist small plutocratic Turkey after the first imperialistic war and the October Revolution, but, there will never be an another Turkey, especially there will never be a Turkey of a population of four hundred and fifty millions after the second World War and when Soviet Russia has completed her socialistic construction. Owing to the special conditions in China (because of the compromising of the capitalist and of the thoroughness of the proletariat), there will never be such a thing which happened in Turkey. After the failure of the Chinese big revolution in 1927, the capitalist in China did shout about the so-called Kemalism. But where is the Kemal in China? Where is the plutocratic government and the capitalistic society in China? Furthermore, the so-called Kemalist Turkey could not but to join eventually into the embrace of the Anglo-French imperialism, became day by day a semi-colony, and a part of the imperialistic reactionary world.
